Dear parents and carers

Please remind your young person to have a read through the notices in the **Student Weekly** for the week ahead; they can find the link to this in their **school email inbox**, and also on **Go4Schools**.

One of our notices this week is about wearing uniform correctly in line with our [Uniform Policy](#). We would really appreciate you working with us on this issue, checking before your young person leaves home in the morning, and reinforcing the importance of maintaining high standards of appearance.

Here are the expectations:

- Carrington or Warwick uniform worn WITH blazer on at all times (11s in the Carrington uniform are the only exception to this)
- Correct footwear – school shoes not trainers, not boots
- Shirts MUST be tucked in
- Skirts MUST NOT be rolled up
- Jewellery – one single band ring, one small pair of earrings (lower lobe only), one concealed necklace. Items not acceptable that will need to be removed before arriving at the gate or they will be confiscated: nose studs (including clear ones), hoop earrings, any earring in upper ear (including hoop ones) and bracelets
- Make up – only 'natural' make up allowed, no false eye lashes, eye liner, eye shadow, lipstick

Additionally, we've had several reports of outbreaks of HEAD LICE so please check that NAME is not carrying any of these tiny invaders and if they are, **pick up a treatment** from the chemist to get rid of them.
