This is a great opportunity to hear scientists who are passionate in a range of fields, talk about recent developments and what excites them:

- Life Changing – Dr Helen Pilcher, Author and Science Communicator
- Seeing Jupiter’s Aurora in a Different Light – Affelia Wibisono, UCL Mullard Space Science Lab
- Wildlife Chain Reactions – Lucy Eckersley, Royal Veterinary College
- How to Freeze a Human – Alex Baker, University of Warwick

We will leave school at 09.00 and travel by train and foot, returning to Redhill by 16.45 (approximately).

Successful applicants will then be asked to make payment of £22 (covering ticket and travel) on ParentPay.

Students should wear school uniform and bring a packed lunch as there is no catering at the venue. Free School Meals students will be provided with a packed lunch by our Catering Contractor.
