Dear parents and carers

The History Department are excited to be taking all the GCSE History students to a theatre play and workshop at The Harlequin in Redhill, which will be extremely beneficial to their studies. They will either attend **The Inquisition of Queen Elizabeth I** that will support the **Elizabethan England** topic on 23 February, or **The Doctor's Show** for our Medicine Through Time topic on 24 February. The teachers will decide which of these experiences will be most beneficial for your young person.

The plays come in four parts and each part leads into a grade-booster workshop linking the events in the play to the GCSE History exam, offering advice to students on how to improve their exam performance. Students will be given a free workbook to take away with them afterwards.

The cost of the play is £15.00 per student and can be paid for online via [ParentPay](#).

If you are not able to pay, the school will ensure that your young person has a ticket, and they will attend the performance that their teacher allocates them to.

Students will be in school uniform with appropriate footwear as it will take part during the morning and students will return for the afternoon. As usual, we will expect a high standard of behaviour at all times. We will leave school at 9am and walk to the theatre. We will then return to school.
