

Religious Studies

Assessment	Revision Help
Revise all topics covered since the start of this academic year in September to the end of the Autumn Term 1 on Unit 1: How do religious and non-religious beliefs influence medical treatment? SKI1 will be marked out of <u>44 marks</u> . The exam will last for 45 minutes (1 hour) (unless you have extra exam concessions such as extra time, in which case, this will be honoured). There will be <u>four sections</u> on the paper:	 Knowledge Organisers Keyword Sheets Exercise books Arbor Seneca
Section A: There will be 6 keyword definition questions (worth 2 marks each) where you will be asked to define the key word (1 mark) and to give an additional piece of information about the keyword (1 mark). Additional pieces of information could be for example- an example of further information known about the keyword. For example, if the keyword is 'omnipotence' then you will get 1 mark for defining the word eg 'The word omnipotence means that God is all-powerful'. You will get a second mark for giving another sentence which contains more information about the definition, for example, 'Christians believe that God is omnipotent as he created the world and everything in it.'	
Section B : multiple choice questions (worth 1 mark each). There will be 7 multiple choice questions on the paper.	
Section C : This is an image section where you will need to identify the items in the images (worth 1 mark for each image identified) and give one additional piece of information about the item. (1 mark each for additional pieces of information). There will be 4 images for you to identify/give information about.	
Section D : This is a written section that contains <u>an outline</u> question (3 marks), an <u>explain questions</u> (4 marks) and an <u>evaluation question</u> (8 marks plus 2 marks SPAG (Spelling, <u>Punctuation and Grammar</u>)). The evaluation question will carry the most marks. For this question, you will be given a statement and you will need to consider arguments for and against the statement.
