

Art SKI Week Preparation

KS3

No revision is required for the Art SKI assessments. All tasks are designed so that students can demonstrate the pencil, observation and design skills they have been learning this year.

Students should bring an HB pencil, biro or fine liner, rubber, sharpener and small ruler to their assessment.

Year 7

Students will be making a detailed study of a crushed can using the grid method.

Year 8

Students will be using images from the Arts and Crafts movement, such as plants, animals and patterns to create a range of compositions for a clay tile. They will be using these designs to create their clay tile after SKI week.

Year 9

Students will be observing sections of portraits in pencil and biro. They will analyse a portrait using the content, form, process, mood, context questioning method.

Year 10

Year 10 must bring their final animal and Celtic design completed on tracing paper and can bring their own apron if they wish. They will be working with clay all day.

Year 10 GCSE students have an all-day (8.30-3.30) examination on Monday 2 June in D002 with Mrs Scott and a visiting artist. They will be making a clay tile, using a design that they have already completed
