

Application Process for East Surrey College & John Ruskin College






1. Head to our website



- 3. Select **Full-time Courses** from the drop down list




4. Click the subject area you are interested in studying.






5. Find the course you would like to apply for and click the 'Apply' button below




6. This will take you to the portal, here you will need to create an account to get started

- 8. Once created it will take you back to the portal page to login with your account details






9. Next step is to complete the application form.

There are 6 stages including:


- Personal details



11. Add in the details of any qualifications you are studying for or have completed. Click 'Add' to add a new qualification.








12. You can upload evidence here to support your application. This could be in relation to your personal situation or in relation to your course.


Select 'Evidence Type', click 'Choose Files' and select your chosen document, then click 'Upload'.

13. Please read through the data protection points and tick the relevant box to confirm your agreement.






Review & Submit

- Even if you start your course in September and change your mind, we can look to move you into a different course, subject to availability.









Booking your Interview

If you have logged out and are returning back later, to book your interview, head to the portal and click 'Home Page'.


Here it highlights where you are in your application progress.








- 16. Select the drop-down to view the dates and times available and select.
