CARRINGTON SCHOOL | 8 DAYS | MOROCCO

DAY ONE

The expedition will start with an administrative session at the school lasting around 2-3 hours to check kit etc. Upon arrival in Marrakesh, the team will transfer to the Riad. Possible visit to the main square in the evening.

DAY TWO

Today the team will depart from the Riad and travel to the mountains. The team will arrive at Imlil and walk to Armed, which will take about 45 minutes. At Armed, the team will have lunch and then they will go out in the afternoon on an acclimatisation trek. The accommodation in Armed (1900m) is in Gites.

DAY THREE

Today is a long trekking day approximately 5-6 hours, with lunch on the way. The trek follows a well-defined trail that zigzags up the valley. There is a small hamlet called Chamarouch on the way where the team can buy snacks and drinks. The team will spend the evening in the Nether Refuge (3100m) which is a typical mountain hut. All meals on the trek are prepared by a Berber cook who will be with the team for the duration.

DAY FOUR

Today the team will have an early start in an attempt to reach the summit (4169m). The trek up will take between 4-5 hours followed by a 3-hour return trip. The team will have some time at the summit to take pictures and enjoy the view. This is a hard day and there are some particularly steep scree filled tracks. Once they have descended, they will spend the night in the Nether Refuge again.

DAY FIVE

After the previous summit day today is a relaxed 3-hour trek taking in the beautiful scenery. Accommodation is back at the Gites in Armed.

EXPEDITIONS WITH A PURPOSE

DAY SIX - SEVEN

Today the team will travel to their project site in the high Atlas Mountains. The team will be working with local communities on sustainable development projects such as reforestation and clean water programmes. Overnight at the project site.

DAY EIGHT

After breakfast, the team will trek back down to Imili and then travel back to Marrakesh where the team has the remainder of the day in the city. They will have their evening meal and stay the night in the Riad, Marrakech.

DAY NINE

After breakfast, the team will depart from the Riad to the airport. Fly back to the UK.
