
Logging in with Single Sign-On (SSO) Logging in with your email address

If you use **Google or Microsoft** to log in to school systems, you can log in to Seneca with these. If you have never logged into Seneca before, it may ask for a password the 1st time, even on SSO.

The default password is: Seneca2025



You can use your school email address to log in. You should have received an email with your password. If you forget your password, you can ask your teacher to reset if for you.

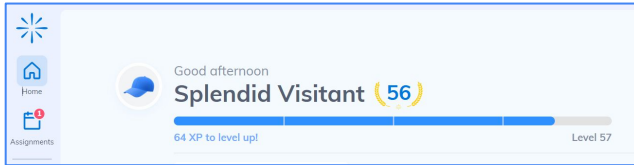

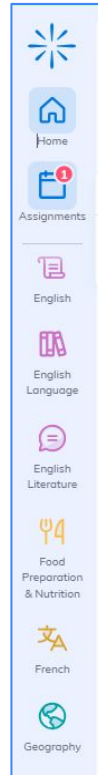
After logging in, you can see:

Use the navigation bar on the left hand side to switch within your subjects.



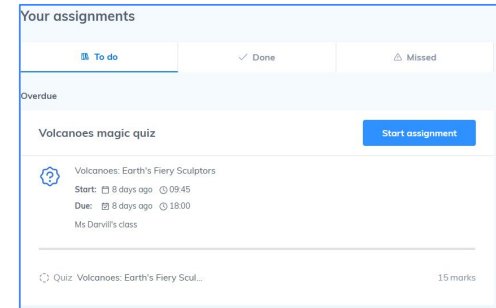
Studying on Seneca
