

## Religion and Ethics-Christianity Section 1-Belief in God




In this section you will learn about:

	Key Concepts	<u>Definitions</u>
1	Begotten	Born of
1	Holy Spirit	The Spirit of God which gives the power to understand and worship
1	Trinity	God as one being, in three persons
2	Free Will	Having the freedom to choose what to do
2	Stewardship	Looking after something that will be passes onto another generation
3	Incarnation	God becomes a human being
4	Resurrection	Rising from the dead
4	Ascension	Going up into heaven
5	Atonement	The action of restoring relationship
5	Repent	To say sorry and turn away from any wrongdoing
5	Salvation	Being saved from sin and the consequences of sin; going to heaven
6	Eschatology	Christian teachings which is all about life after death
6	Immortal Soul	A soul that lives on after the death of the body
6	Purgatory	A place where the souls of the dead are cleansed and prepared for heaven
7	Natural Evil	Suffering caused by natural events such as earthquakes
7	Moral Evil	Suffering caused by humans such as murder
7	Omnipotence	God is all powerful
7	Omniscience	God is all knowing
7	Omnipresence	God is everywhere
7	Benevolence	God is all good/loving
8	Intercession	Prayers for those who are suffering
