1	<b>Begotten</b>	Born of
1	<b>Holy Spirit</b>	The Spirit of God which gives the power to understand and worship
1	<b>Trinity</b>	God as one being, in three persons
2	<b>Free Will</b>	Having the freedom to choose what to do
2	<b>Stewardship</b>	Looking after something that will be passes onto another generation
3	<b>Incarnation</b>	God becomes a human being
4	<b>Resurrection</b>	Rising from the dead
4	<b>Ascension</b>	Going up into heaven
5	<b>Atonement</b>	The action of restoring relationship
5	<b>Repent</b>	To say sorry and turn away from any wrongdoing
5	<b>Salvation</b>	Being saved from sin and the consequences of sin; going to heaven
6	<b>Eschatology</b>	Christian teachings which is all about life after death
6	<b>Immortal Soul</b>	A soul that lives on after the death of the body
6	<b>Purgatory</b>	A place where the souls of the dead are cleansed and prepared for heaven
7	<b>Natural Evil</b>	Suffering caused by natural events such as earthquakes
7	<b>Moral Evil</b>	Suffering caused by humans such as murder
7	<b>Omnipotence</b>	God is all powerful
7	<b>Omniscience</b>	God is all knowing
7	<b>Omnipresence</b>	God is everywhere
7	<b>Benevolence</b>	God is all good/loving
8	<b>Intercession</b>	Prayers for those who are suffering
