- You can have instrumental and singing lessons with a private tutor at Carrington School
- Lessons are 30 minute, one-to-one lessons
- Lessons take place during the school day
- At £15-18 per lesson, the price for lessons is half of what you would pay for private lessons outside of school
- Certain instruments (flute, clarinet, trumpet, trombone, guitar) can be hired from the music department for £30 per term, so you can try before you buy

ABOUT THE CLASSES

1-1 private singing lessons take place at school for 30 minutes a week. Students can choose when to have their lesson based on their timetable. In class students are given sheet music and encouraged to bring a folder to class.

In class, students work towards learning examination pieces, preparing for auditions and performances, or singing just for fun. The choice is completely up to the student.

Through my years of teaching singing, I have worked with children of all ages and abilities. I have successfully helped students build confidence & wider their knowledge in music, learning to project their voices safely whilst encouraging improvement in their theory, vocal range and music ability.
