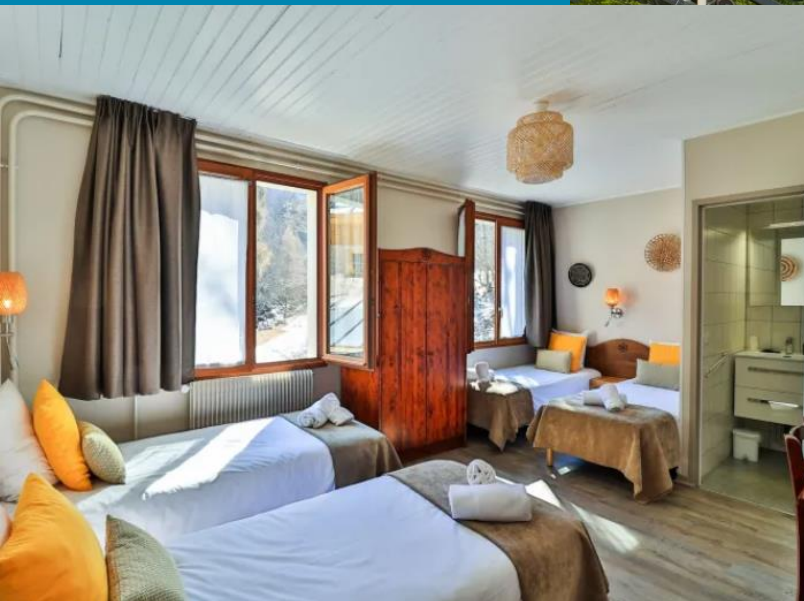

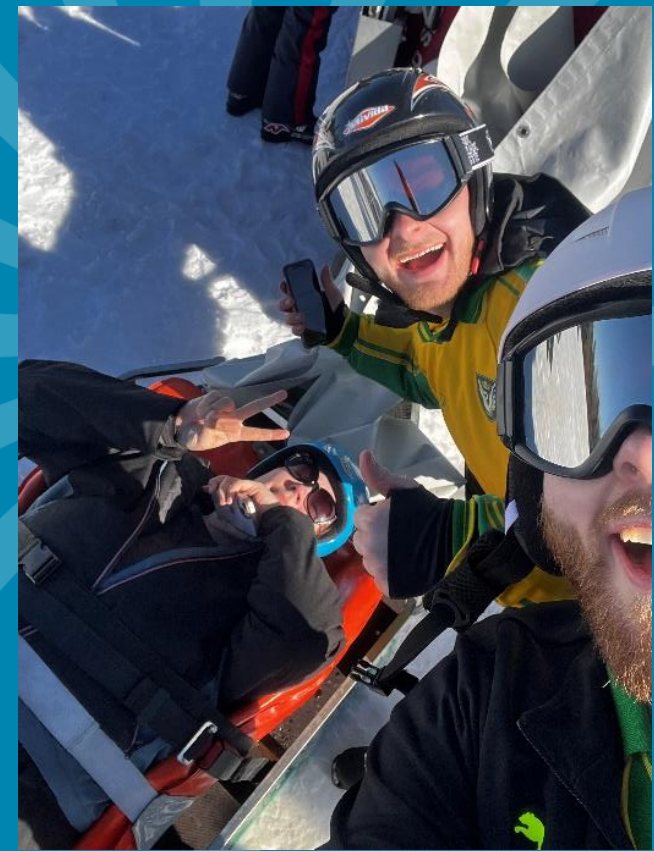

Layer 1: Thermal top / base layer - fits like a 2nd skin close to skin. Keeps you warm!

Layer 2: Mid Layer - retains heat. Warm but light layer. No hood.

Layer 3: Jacket - protects you from the elements- balance of rain & wind resistance and breathability. Allows freedom of movement.

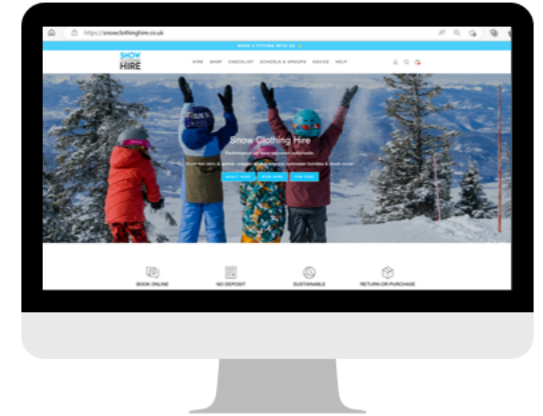

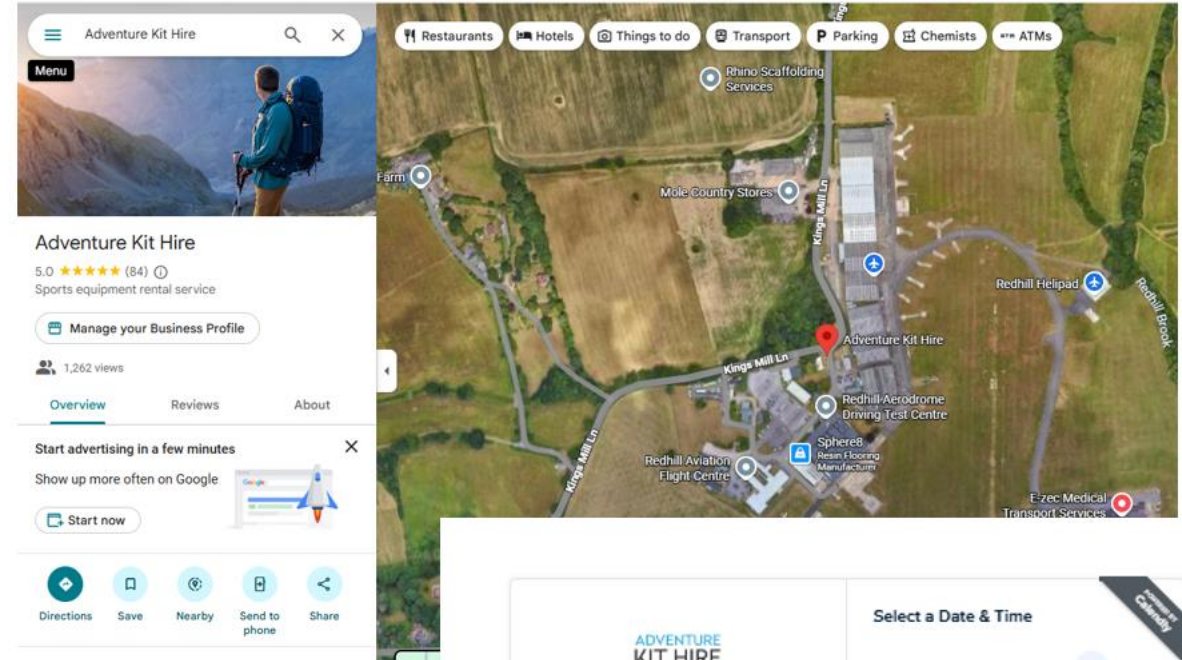
