

GCSE Revision: BTEC Tech Award Level 2 Performing Arts

Component 1:

Learners will develop their understanding of the performing arts by examining the work of performing arts professionals and the processes used to create performance. Students will need to research an existing performance and the theatre industry during this unit for homework.

Component 2:

Learners will develop their performing arts skills and techniques through the reproduction of acting repertoire as performers or designers. Students will need to be available to rehearse during this period and will complete write ups of their rehearsals for homework.

Component 3

Learners will be given the opportunity to work as part of a group to contribute to a workshop performance in response to a brief and stimulus. Students will need to be available to rehearse during this period and prepare notes for their written log exams.
