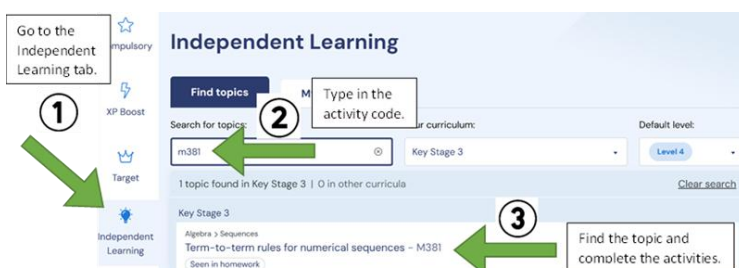

Religious Studies

Assessment	Revision Help
<p>Revise all topics covered since the start of this academic year in September to May.</p> <p>SKI2 will be marked out of 40 marks. The exam will last for 45 minutes (unless you have extra exam concessions such as extra time, in which case, this will be honoured). There will be four sections on the paper:</p> <p>Section A: There will be 5 keyword definition questions (worth 2 marks each) where you will be asked to define the key word (1 mark) and to give an additional piece of information about the keyword (1 mark). Additional pieces of information could be for example- an example of further information known about the keyword. For example, if the keyword is 'omnipotence' then you will get 1 mark for defining the word eg '<i>The word omnipotence means that God is all-powerful</i>'. You will get a second mark for giving another sentence which contains more information about the definition, for example, '<i>Christians believe that God is omnipotent as he created the world and everything in it.</i>'</p> <p>Section B: multiple choice questions (worth 1 mark each). There will be 5 multiple choice questions on the paper.</p> <p>Section C: This is an image section where you will need to identify the items in the images (worth 1 mark for each image identified) and give one additional piece of information about the item. (1 mark each for additional pieces of information). There will be 3 images for you to identify/give information about.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Knowledge Organisers • Keyword Sheets • Exercise books • Arbor • Seneca

Section D: This is a written section that contains an **outline question (3 marks)**, an **explain questions (4 marks)** and an **evaluation question (10 marks plus 2 marks SPAG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar))**. The evaluation question will carry the most marks. For this question, you will be given a statement and you will need to consider arguments for and against the statement.

<p>Drama - Students will be tested on their knowledge and understanding of acting skills (vocal and physical) and drama performance techniques. They will then be asked to evaluate their performance assessment in full sentences, focusing on their characterisation skills and offering clear evaluation on what was successful and what could have been improved.</p> <p>Music - The students will need to revise the key musical elements studied during this unit. This includes understanding and being able to define rhythm, pitch, tempo, dynamics, texture, timbre, harmony and structure. Students should be able to explain how these elements are used in music and how they affect the sound of a performance. Students are also expected to revise the concept of chords, including the three main chords used in the 12-bar blues, and understand how musical elements combine to create a successful performance.</p>	<p>Drama - BBC Bitesize</p> <p>Drama Techniques - Drama Teachers</p>
