Dear parents and carers

Following the success of previous Year 7 **residential trips to Bude in Cornwall**, we are really excited to be able to offer another **residential activity holiday there for Year 7 students**. This trip will provide a range of experiences; we want our young people to have fun, build friendships and make memories. Students will surf, canoe, body board, as well as complete a high ropes course and have a range of evening entertainment to keep them busy!

We will be departing on **Monday 8 June 2026** and returning on **Friday 12 June 2026**.

We anticipate demand will be high and there are a **limited number of places**, so please take careful note of the process for requesting a place on this trip:

Step 1

Request a place by submitting [THIS REQUEST FORM](#), which will become live at 6:00pm on Wednesday 12 November.

- The link is not accessible until that time
- Your submission will be date and time stamped
- Places will be allocated to the **first 75** respondents; after this, applicants will be registered on a Waiting List
- The form will close at 9:00am on Friday 14 November
- **We will notify you by email if you have been allocated one of these 75 places on Friday 14 November**

Step 2

If you are allocated a place, you need to secure it by paying the deposit. ParentPay will be opened only to those who are allocated a place, on Friday, and you will have a week to pay your deposit. Any places not secured with a deposit payment will be offered to the next on the waiting list.

Payment

The full cost of the trip is **£610**, which includes travel from the school by coach, insurance, all day and evening activities, tours and equipment, accommodation and all meals (except for those for the journey there).

Deposit £110 if allocated a place, by Friday 21 November

Payment 1 £100 by 20 January

Payment 2 £100 by 20 February

Payment 3 £100 by 20 March

Payment 4 £100 by 20 April

Payment 5 £100 by 20 May



If you would like your young person to go on this trip BUT the cost is not affordable to you, we can look at allocating funds from the [ACE Foundation](#) to cover some of it.
