The full timetable will start from Monday 15 September, however, the following clubs WILL run this week:

- STEM Computing (Thursday) this club is for any students (beginner to intermediate) to help boost programming confidence through fun, hands-on challenges; support revision and reinforce key concepts for Y10 and Y11 students and introducing AI in a practical and engaging way. This is NOT Gaming (that is a separate club).
- Badminton with Alex (Friday) Alex is an L1 Badminton coach and former county level payer. You

- Y7 Girls Football Taster Session (Friday) this is an opportunity for any Y7 girls to come along and give football a try and showcase their abilities ahead of squad decisions.

It is the Carrington Way to encourage extra-curricular engagement and at KS3 it is an expectation that all students attend at least one club a week. We have some fantastic new clubs this term including Fitness Club, Ballet, Community Club, our whole school musical, Oliver as well as many old favourites such as Gaming, Dungeons & Dragons, Chess, Table Tennis and Carrington Band, plus many more.
