Dear parents and carers

Following a really successful ClubFest last week, we're **pleased to publish our [NEW Autumn Clubs timetable](#)**, featuring lots of opportunities for your young person to get involved in something that will help them build skills, develop teamwork and resilience, improve their confidence and make friends.

The full timetable will start from Monday 14 September. The majority of clubs run after school from 15:15-16:15 (Mon - Thurs) and 14:25-15:25 (Fri). Clubs that run outside of these times are noted on the calendar and can be identified by a symbol next to the information.

It is the Carrington Way to encourage extra-curricular engagement and at KS3 it is an expectation that all students attend at least one club a week. We have some fantastic clubs this term including Art Club, Ballet, Badminton, Carrington Singers, Cinema Club, Dungeons & Dragons, Netball and Football, plus many more.

Unless otherwise stated (highlighted in yellow on the timetable), there is no need to sign up to any clubs, just come along to the room on the timetable and get stuck in! For clubs requiring sign up, this can be done via Arbor. If your young person then attends the club and decides it is not for them, that is fine, but they will need to let the teacher know so your young person can be removed from the class list which will allow another student to take their place.
