Acceptable non-uniform

- Leggings
- Shorts
- Shoes/trainers

What not to wear

- Offensive slogans on clothing
- Anything showing off tummy's
- Strappy or low-cut tops
- Hotpants
- Mini Skirts
- Overly ripped jeans
- Flip flops or sliders
- High heeled shoes

The School Uniform and Jewellery policies still apply. Students should come to school dressed in a neat and tidy manner with acceptable length skirts.

We also remind you that school will finish at normal time on Friday 22 May and we will welcome students back on Monday 1 June at the normal start time.
