Dear parents and carers

The Immunisation Team will be returning to school on **Friday 19 June** to give the HPV vaccination to our year 8 students that haven't already had it.

**If you haven't already done so, please complete the e-consent form by visiting [www.surreyimmunisations.co.uk](http://www.surreyimmunisations.co.uk) and entering our unique code/URN number **SR143903**. *This is an important vaccine for both boys and girls.* The HPV virus increases the risk of developing some cancers in later life, such as cervical cancer, some mouth and throat cancers and some cancers of the anus and genital areas. Evidence is clear that the HPV vaccine helps protect both boys and girls from HPV-related cancers. If you do not want your young person to receive a vaccine, then please fill in the 'No' box.**
