We are excited to offer Year 10s **TWO fantastic overseas opportunities** taking place in Year 11 (2027).

True Adventures Expedition to Morocco

At the end of Year 11, students have the opportunity to complete a **True Adventures expedition to Morocco** where they will contribute to local communities via charity work. This trip will **officially launch in January 2026** with an assembly and parent/carer webinar. **The cost of this trip will be in the region of £2600 but students are encouraged to fundraise** to help cover the cost. Ski Trip

During the **Easter half-term 2027** we will be travelling to Le Grand Massif in the French Alps, partnering with a highly reputable ski company who specialise in school ski trips to Europe. We will be departing on **Saturday 27 March 2027** and returning on **Saturday 3 April 2027**.

We anticipate demand will be high and there is a limited number of places, so please take careful note of the process for requesting a place on this trip:

Step 1

Request a place by submitting [THIS REQUEST FORM](#), which will become **live at 7:00pm on Wednesday 26 November**

- The link is not accessible until that time
- Your submission will be date and time stamped
- Places will be allocated to the first 49 respondents; after this, applicants will be registered on a Waiting List
- The form will **close at midday on Monday 1 December** and we will notify you after this time if you have been allocated one of these 49 places or not
- **Note that we reserve the right to withhold or withdraw places where we are concerned about the behaviour and/or attitudes of a student, particularly when taking trips abroad**

Step 2

If you are allocated a place you need to secure it by paying the non-refundable deposit. ParentPay will be opened only to those who are allocated a place on **Monday 1 December**, and you will have until 10:00am on 12 December to pay the deposit. ***Any places not secured with a deposit payment will be offered to the next on the waiting list.***



Payment

The full cost of the trip will be no more than £1310 (this amount could be less, dependent on numbers, and we will let you know if this is the case). The cost includes all travel, accommodation, ski boots, poles & helmets along with the lift pass for the whole resort, not to mention 5 hours tuition a day for 5 days and some apres ski activities across our stay. The meals package comprises a buffet-style breakfast, a hot lunch on the mountain and three course meal in the evening. Included within the price are the local tourist tax and travel insurance.

Deposit **£100 (if allocated a place) by Friday 12 December (10:00am)**

Payment 1 £200 by 1 February 2026

Payment 2 £200 by 1 April 2026

Payment 3 £200 by 1 June 2026

Payment 4 £200 by 1 August 2026

Payment 5 £200 by 1 October 2026

Payment 6 £210 by 1 December 2026
