We are really delighted and excited to introduce to you our **Culture & Challenge Days '25**, which are coming up on **Wednesday 9 July and Thursday 10 July**.

These two days are off-timetable, **for all students***, offering an array of enriching activities both in-school and out, that provide opportunities to get beyond the academic curriculum, have some fun with peers and staff members, some cultural experiences and some personal challenges to build their skills and open their minds to possibilities for the future.

Details of the activities for each year group, and the cost associated are in the table below. In putting together these packages we have been mindful of the cost of living and have tried to keep these as low as we possibly can without compromising on the students' experience.

Year 8

Half the year group will go to The Light on Wednesday and take part in Crystal Maze games on Thursday and the other half will do Crystal Maze games on Wednesday and The Light on Thursday.

Three activities from a choice of five (bowling, climbing, crazy golf, pool & darts, shuffleboard) at **The Light** in **Redhill** in the morning, followed by a **cinema experience** in the afternoon. Lunch is included

Crystal Maze Games with a variety of physical, mental & skills-based challenges to develop team-work, leadership, problem-solving and initiative, taking place here in our grounds

9-Mile Challenge Circular Hike around the North Downs, from and back to the school, appreciating our beautiful local and natural surroundings

Trip to Chessington Zoo & World of Adventures (transport by coach)
