Dear parents and carers

We are offering students that will be studying a Technology GCSE subject (Product Design, Engineering, Textiles and Hospitality and Catering) in Year 10 a fantastic opportunity to participate in a **trip to Disneyland Paris** from **Sunday 18 January to Wednesday 21 January 2026**.

What's the Aim of the Trip

We are using a specialist educational Study Experience company 'studyexperiences.co.uk' and will be travelling to and from Carrington School by coach. The aim of this trip is to bring the classroom teaching of these technology subjects alive through a DT seminar and interactive workshop based in Disneyland Paris in which students will gain first-hand experience of their subjects in real-life environments. It will also give them the fun experience of the world-renowned Disneyland and the chance to visit Paris and its iconic sights.

What's Included

- Return coach travel and Channel crossings from school to Disneyland Paris
- Three nights' hotel accommodation at a Disney Hotel on a bed & continental breakfast board
- Two-day Hopper Ticket to Disneyland Park and Walt Disney Studios Park
- Visit to Paris and entrance to the Eiffel Tower
- One curriculum-led Seminar hosted by the Study Experiences facilitator
- One Interactive DT workshop
- Time permitting, a visit to Carrefore on the way home
- Fully comprehensive travel insurance with AXA Travel

Students must have a valid passport and will need some spending money for lunches, dinners and snacks.

We anticipate demand will be high and there is a **limited number of places**, so **please take careful note of the process for requesting a place on this trip**:

Step 1

Request a place by submitting **THIS REQUEST FORM**, which will **become live at 6:00pm on Thursday 26 June**.

- The link is not accessible until that time
- Your submission will be date and time stamped
- Places will be allocated to the **first 40** respondents; after this, applicants will be registered on a Waiting List
- The form will close at 9:00am on Monday 30 June
- We will notify you by email if you have been allocated one of these 40 places or not by Tuesday 1 July

Step 2

If you are allocated a place, you need to secure it by paying the deposit. ParentPay will be opened only to those who are allocated a place next week, and you will have 10 days to pay your deposit.

Payment

The full cost of the trip is **£605**.

Payment 4	£100 by 30 November
