Box Hill, Wednesday 15 April

On the **first Wednesday back at school after Easter**, we will visit **Box Hill** for a 5km walk, picnic and forest school activities.

Arrive at School: Normal time, 8:30am

Wear: Full PE Kit

Bring: Coat, suitable shoes for walking, water bottle, packed lunch (if you are in receipt of Free School Meals, a packed lunch will be provided by school)

Travel: By school minibus

Finish: We expect to arrive back at school at approximately 2:30pm

Science Museum, Tuesday 19 May

On **Tuesday 19 May**, we will visit the **Science Museum in London**.

Arrive at School: 8:30am

Wear: Full school uniform

Bring: Coat, water bottle, packed lunch (if you are in receipt of Free School Meals, a packed lunch will be provided by school). Up to £10 to spend in the gift shop (optional).

Travel: By train - catching the train from Redhill to London Victoria. We will then take the underground for two stops and it is just a short walk from South Kensington to the museum.

Finish: We expect to arrive back at school at approximately 2:45pm



Mercers Lake AQUA Sports, Monday 29 June

On **Monday 29 June**, we will be visiting **Mercers Lake** for a morning of watersports activities.

Arrive at School: 8:30am

Wear: Full PE Kit

Bring: Water bottle, snack, water shoes or old shoes that you don't mind getting wet, a towel, swimwear to wear under the wetsuit. There is a cafe on site so Your young person may bring cards/cash to buy a snack.

Travel: By school minibus

Finish: We expect to arrive back at school at approximately 12:30pm
