If you haven't yet done so, there's still time to tell us if you do or don't want your young person to have this important vaccine!

The Immunisation Team are coming to give our 9s this important vaccination, completing a set that they began in Primary school. They'll be here next Wednesday on **6 March**.

It is very quick to give or with-hold your consent, just click this link for the consent form: www.surreyimmunisations.co.uk and enter our unique code **SR143903**. The form will close at **midday THIS Friday 1 March**. This allows time for our nurses to review and contact you if there are any concerns, prior to the session.

These vaccinations protect against **Diphtheria, Tetanus & Polio** and **Meningococcal ACWY**.

An automated email will be sent to you on completion of the e-consent from Cinnamon Digital Applications who host the website portal for us. If you do not receive this, please check in your junk or spam email or contact the Immunisation Team.

- **Diphtheria/Tetanus/Polio** final 3-in-1 school booster protects against diphtheria, tetanus and polio. This vaccination will complete the baby injections given pre-school.
- **Meningococcal ACWY** protects against the four strains of meningitis known as ACWY. These diseases are known to affect older adolescents, especially if they go to university or training where they are living in accommodation with other young people.

GDPR

On the 25 May 2018 the new EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) came into force bringing with it improvements to Data Protection Regulations. GDPR was enacted into UK Law by the UK Data Protection Act 2018. Under the GDPR organisations have a statutory responsibility to have a Legal Basis when gathering and processing certain data. While we will continue to seek your explicit consent for the treatment of your child/children, your information will be processed under the following GDPR articles:

Article 6 (1) (e)

For the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority.

Article 9(2)(h)

Necessary for the reasons of preventative or occupational medicine, for assessing the working capacity of the employee, medical diagnosis, the provision of health or social care or treatment or management of health or social care systems and services on the basis of Union or Member State law or a contract with a health professional.
