Options Online Opens - 27 February	Your young person will be emailed a link to make Options Choices. Places are not offered on a first come, first served basis so your young person should take time to make considered choices.
Groupwork sessions and 1-2-1 careers chats – Scheduled for early March	Your young person will have the opportunity to chat with our Careers Lead, Mrs Pearce
Options Online Closes - 23 March	This is the deadline for all Options choices.

We undertake a review of our Key Stage 4 offer each year, so please do not assume that our Key Stage 4 curriculum will look the same as in previous years. This means that the information **currently** on our website may not all be relevant to your young person.
