Dear parents and carers

I wrote to you in April about our exciting Culture & Challenge Days which are coming up soon, on **Wednesday 9 and Thursday 10 July.** I am now pleased to be able to provide the specific details for your young person for these events.

Wildwood, Guildford

The students will take part in the high tree top rope course and three aerial challenges – "leap of faith", "Jacobs ladder" and "telegraph pole". They will be travelling by coach to Guildford.

Meet time: 08:00 outside Altair building

Clothing: Own clothes, please wear long sleeve top and joggers/sports leggings to minimise discomfort from the full-body harness. Students may wish to bring gloves for added protection.

Extras: Packed lunch is essential (if you are in receipt of Free School Meals, a packed lunch will be provided for you), snacks, water, personal medication to be kept with the student across the day (asthma pumps & auto injectors), sun cream. There is a small snack shack, so [NAME] may wish to bring a card to buy something to eat.

Here in the school grounds, the students will have a practical hands on (for those brave enough!) and interactive day with displays from Huxley's Birds of Prey Centre and Tom's Talking Reptiles and talks from the Terrence Higgins Trust and Tony Kelly Red Card Gambling.

Clothing: Full PE kit including weatherproof jacket should the weather be inclement.

Extras: Packed lunch optional or food available as a normal school day from The Observatory, water, personal medication to be kept with the student across the day (asthma pumps & auto injectors), sun cream. **No mobile phones allowed.**

Finish time: 15:00
