Dear parents and carers

The Immunisation Team are coming to us on **16 May, 20 June and 18 July** to give the HPV vaccination to our year 8 students.

If you haven't already done so, please complete the e-consent form before 12 noon on 12 May by visiting <u>www.surreyimmunisations.co.uk</u> and entering our unique code/URN number SR143903. If you do not want your young person to receive a vaccine, then please fill in the 'No' box. *This is an important vaccine for both boys and girls, as it will protect them from a whole range of cancers.*

An automated email will be sent to you on completion of the e-consent form from school.immunisations@nhs.net. If you do not receive this, please check in your junk email or contact the Immunisation team.

If your child has NOT had two doses of MMR, and you would like them to be protected, please complete the MMR consent form.
