Dear parents and carers

As you will know from the SKI assessment timetable, your young person's Maths assessment tomorrow (Friday 5 June) will take place in the Sports Hall. This is an opportunity for Y9 to have a taste of what the real GCSE exams will be like in a few years time.

Seating plans will be displayed on the Observatory windows and your young person should check where their seat is before entering the Sports Hall. Inside the hall there is a grid system in place (letters and numbers) which will help students locate their seat.

Bags, phones and any electronic devices, including smart watches, should be left in lockers - they are not allowed in the Sports Hall. Your young person should bring only the equipment they need for the exam and should bring a clear water bottle. Please remind them to also bring a calculator. There will be spare equipment available to borrow, should they need it they can raise their hand and an invigilator will bring this to them.

On entering the exam hall all students must be silent and remain so until they have fully left the hall.
