What not to wear

- Strappy or low-cut tops
- Hotpants
- Mini Skirts
- Overly ripped jeans
- Flip flops or sliders
- High heeled shoes

The School Uniform and Jewellery policies still apply. Students should come to school dressed in a neat and tidy manner with acceptable length skirts.

We also remind you that school will finish at normal time on Friday 13 February and we will welcome students back on Monday 23 February at normal time.
