The Immunisation Team are coming into school on **10 January and also on 6 March** to carry out vaccinations against **Diphtheria, Tetanus & Polio** and **Meningococcal ACWY** for students in **Year 9**.

**They require your consent for this** and you can state which vaccines you would like your young person to receive. If you do not want them to receive a vaccine, then please fill in the 'NO' box.

Please complete the e-consent form by **midday 5 January when the portal will close**. This allows time for our nurses to review and contact you if there are any concerns, prior to the session.

An automated email will be sent to you on completion of the e-consent from Cinnamon Digital Applications who host the website portal for us. If you do not receive this, please check in your junk or spam email or contact the Immunisation Team.

- **Diphtheria/Tetanus/Polio** final 3-in-1 school booster protects against diphtheria, tetanus and polio. This vaccination will complete the baby injections given pre-school.
- **Meningococcal ACWY** protects against the four strains of meningitis known as ACWY. These diseases are known to affect older adolescents, especially if they go to university or training where they are living in accommodation with other young people.
