Dear parents and carers

We are really excited to be able to offer **current Year 8 and Year 9 students the opportunity to visit Iceland for four days/three nights in July 2027.**

The trip will include

- Accommodation for three nights
- Full board (breakfast, packed lunch and evening meal, not including drinks)
- Reykjanes Peninsula Tour, South Shore Adventure and Golden Circle Tour; all include private coach and experienced guide
- Entry to Hellisheidi Geothermal Power Plant
- Entry to the LAVA Volcano and Earthquake Centre in Hvolsvöllur
- Entry to bathe at the Secret Lagoon
- Comprehensive Travel and Medical Insurance

Students must have a valid passport.

The provisional dates are Sunday 4 July 2027 (very early morning) and returning on Wednesday 7 July 2027 (early evening). **The proposed cost is approximately £1200.**

How to Book a Place on this Trip

We anticipate demand will be high and there are a **limited number of places**, so please take careful note of the process for requesting a place on this trip below. ***Year 9 students who previously signed up for the Iceland trip will be prioritised, however, you must still complete the form so we know you are still interested.***

Step 1

Request a place by submitting [THIS REQUEST FORM](#), which will **become live at 6:00pm on Monday 10 November.**

- The link will not be accessible until that time
- Your submission will be date and time stamped
- Places will be allocated to the **first 40 respondents**; after this, applicants will be registered on a Waiting List
- The form will **close at 9:00am on Wednesday 12 November**
- **We will notify you by email if you have been allocated one of these places on Wednesday 12 November**



Step 2

If you are allocated a place, you need to secure it by paying the deposit. ParentPay will be opened on Wednesday 12 November only to those who are allocated a place, and you will have 7 days to pay your deposit.

The provisional cost of the trip is **£1200**, which includes coaches, flights, insurance, all day and evening activities, accommodation and all meals. Below is the provisional payment plan which may be subject to change.

Non-Refundable 1st Deposit	£250 if allocated a place, by 19 Nov 2025
Non-Refundable 2nd Deposit	£200 by 1 January 2026 (TBC)
Payment 1	£195 by 1 April 2026
Payment 2	£195 by 1 July 2026
Payment 3	£195 by 1 November 2026
Payment 4	£195 by 1 April 2027
