We are really excited to be able to offer **THREE exciting residential opportunities for the next academic year.**

**DT Trip to Paris, January 2027, £650 – AVAILABLE TO CURRENT YEAR 9S TAKING A DT SUBJECT IN YEAR 10**

We are offering students studying a Technology GCSE subject (Product Design, Engineering, Textiles and Hospitality and Catering) a fantastic opportunity to participate in a **trip to Disneyland Paris** from **Sunday 17 January to Wednesday 20 January.**

**What's the Aim of the Trip**

We are using a specialist educational Study Experience company 'studyexperiences.co.uk' and will be travelling to and from Carrington School by coach. The aim of this trip is to bring the classroom teaching of these technology subjects alive through a DT seminar and interactive workshop based in Disneyland Paris in which students will gain first-hand experience of their subjects in real-life environments. It will also give them the fun experience of the world-renowned Disneyland and the chance to visit Paris and its iconic sights.

**What's Included**

Return coach travel and Channel crossings from school to Disneyland® Paris

- Three nights' hotel accommodation at the Disney's Cheyenne Hotel on a bed & continental breakfast board
- Two-day Hopper Ticket to Disneyland® Park and Walt Disney Studios® Park
- Visit to Paris and entrance to the Eiffel Tower
- One curriculum-led Seminar hosted by the Study Experiences facilitator
- Time permitting, a visit to Carrefore on the way home

**Spain Sports Week, April 2027, £770 – AVAILABLE TO CURRENT YEAR 8s & YEAR 9s**

Students will spend their time training with professional coaches in their chosen sport, playing matches and there will be the opportunity to visit Port Aventura theme park. We will be staying in a hotel in Lloret de Mar on a half board basis (breakfast and dinner are provided). Comprehensive travel insurance is included as well as a Carrington trip



hoodie. ***This trip will take place during the school Easter holidays - Sunday 28 March to Saturday 3 April 2027.***

Students must choose from one of the following sports (if they already play for the school or a club outside school this would be beneficial; if not, attending the after school club ahead of the trip would certainly help):

- Boys Football
- Girls Football
- Netball
- Basketball
- Dance (minimum 10 people)

**Students must have a valid passport and any relevant travel documents and will need spending money for lunches and snacks.**

**Iceland, July 2027, £1200 – AVAILABLE TO CURRENT YEAR 8s & YEAR 9s**

We also have **three remaining spaces available** on our trip to Iceland, taking place **between 4-7 July 2027.**

The trip will include:

- Accommodation for three nights
- Full board (breakfast, packed lunch and evening meal, not including drinks)
- Reykjanes Peninsula Tour, South Shore Adventure and Golden Circle Tour; all include private coach and experienced guide
- Entry to Hellisheidi Geothermal Power Plant
- Entry to the LAVA Volcano and Earthquake Centre in Hvolsvöllur
- Entry to bathe at the Secret Lagoon
- Comprehensive Travel and Medical Insurance

**Students must have a valid passport and any relevant travel documents.**

#### **Step 1**

Request a place on one/all trip(s) by submitting the forms below, which will **become live at 6:00pm on Thursday 11 June**. The links are not accessible until that time.

- Your submission will be date and time stamped
- Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Once all places are taken, applicants will be registered on a Waiting List
- There are **50 places available on the Paris Trip; 100 places available on the Spain Trip** and the **last 3 places on the Iceland Trip**
- The form will close at 8:00am on Monday 15 June
- **We will notify you by email if you have been allocated one of these places on Monday 15 June**

## Step 2

If you are allocated a place, you need to secure it by paying the deposit. ParentPay will be opened on Monday 15 June only to those who are allocated a place, and you will have 10 days to pay your deposit.

### Payment for Paris

The full cost of the trip is **£650**, which includes coaches, ferries, insurance, all day and evening activities, accommodation and breakfast.
