

Extra-Curricular, Trips & Activities

Our students are included in the majority of activities and trips offered by Carrington School. In addition, WEC @Carrington provides a range of trips exclusively for our students, separate from those offered by Carrington School. These may include activities such as water sports at Mercers Lake, visits to the Science Museum, Watts Gallery, and more. These experiences complement aspects of the curriculum and help to make learning more meaningful and engaging.

Excellence and Enrichment

As part of Carrington School, we provide a wide range of enrichment opportunities, including access to specialist clubs such as boxing, golf, and football. The Excellence Programme offers all students the chance to explore new interests that may lead to enterprise opportunities, employment, further study, or greater independence through leisure activities and extended interests.

Duke of Edinburgh Award (DofE)

The Duke of Edinburgh's Award (DofE) is offered to students from Year 9 onwards. The award consists of four sections: Volunteering, Physical, Skills, and Expedition.

The Bronze Award takes a minimum of six months to complete, while the Silver Award requires a minimum of twelve months. Through DofE, students demonstrate commitment and develop a strong sense of community by engaging in a range of activities. They also grow in responsibility as they take ownership of their award and their personal development.
